



2 Making the city affordable for all

- Political will is required to provide services more efficiently to all citizens, sharing the cost evenly between them

- Society and the economy have to undergo a systematic transformation to turn slums into a regular part of the city

- Priority should be given to the urban integration of informal settlements to make resources accessible to all urban communities



1 Interconnectivity: at the edge of (in)formality

- All areas of the city are interconnected, and each of them contributes to public health
- Informal settlements must be rethought as an integrated part of the city



- Political leaders must accept urban diversity in order to build a more resilient and inclusive city

3 Envisaging a long-term urban plan

- The first step to building an inclusive urban area is to mobilise the people who live in the city
- Urban inequality is one of the main challenges to be addressed during Covid-19 recovery, with a view to long-term transformation
- Metropolitan plans need to build physical connectivity to all metropolitan communities
