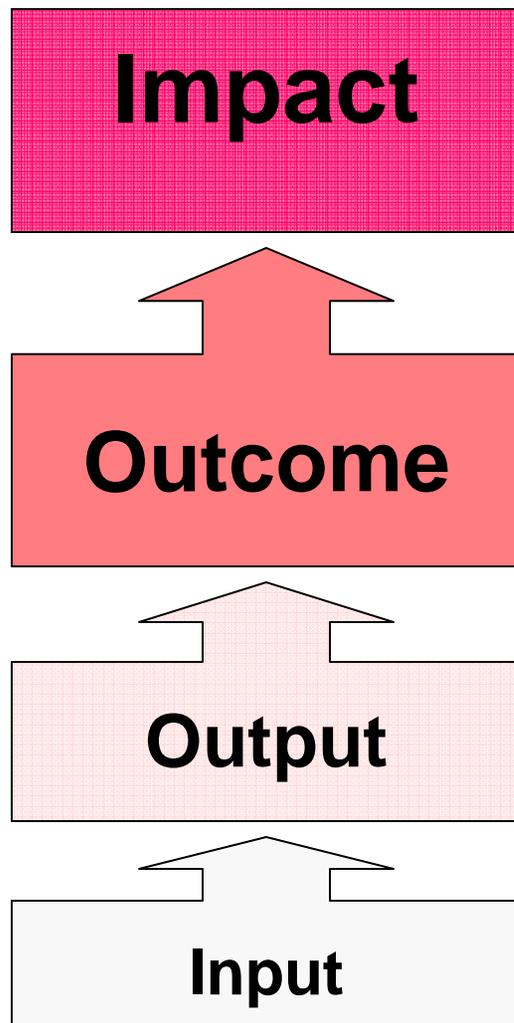

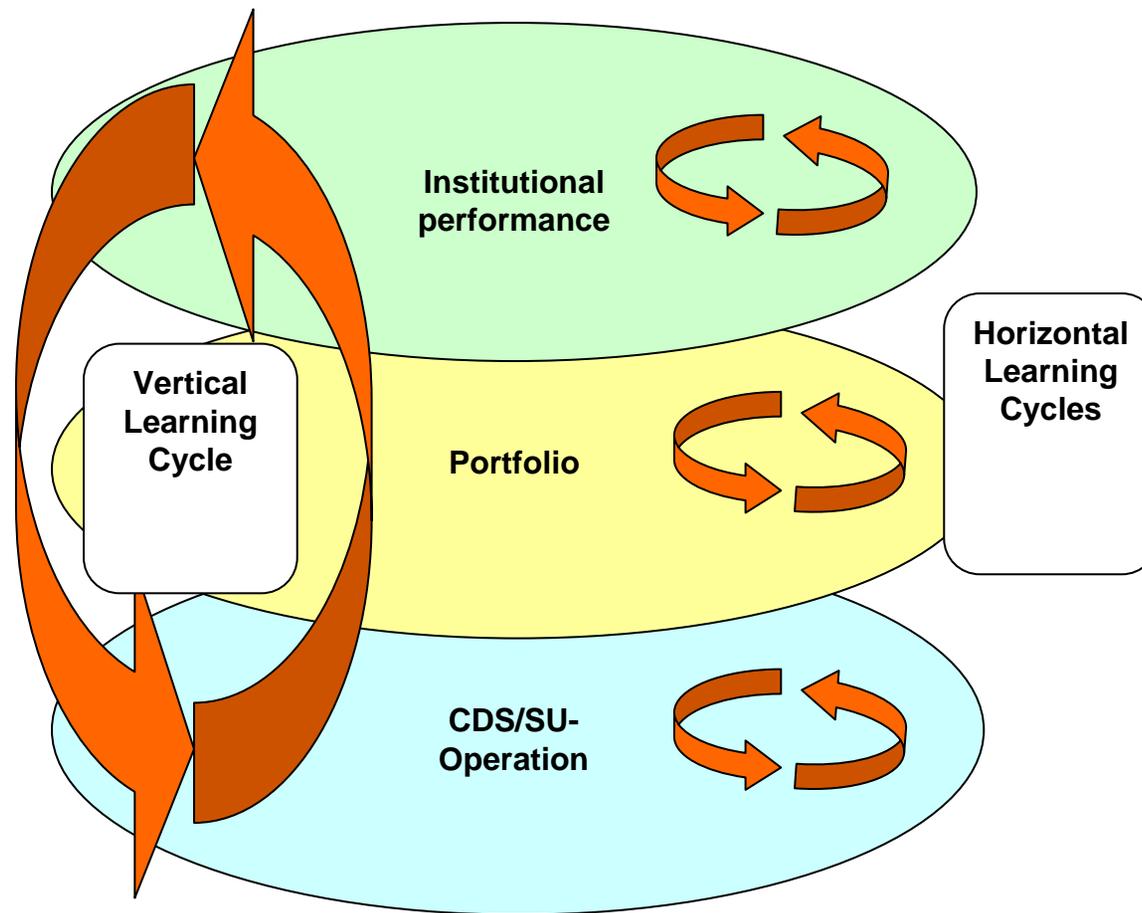


Why M+E?



- ❖ M+E as an incentive for **learning**, for
 - ❑ Partner cities and countries,
 - ❑ CA members and
 - ❑ CA secretariat
- ❖ M+E generates **knowledge**, also for dissemination
- ❖ Challenge: move up the impact chain, less attention on inputs, more attention on **outcomes and impacts**

- ❖ **Composition and quality of project portfolio**
- ❖ **Annual Portfolio Review**
- ❖ **Challenges:**
 - **What portfolio do we have, in terms of poverty reduction, policy advice,?**
 - **What portfolio do we want?**
 - **How do we get it?**

M+E on CA Level

- ❖ **M+E on what?**
- ❖ **CA = members, partners + secretariat**
- ❖ **M+E tool: results framework**
 - ❑ 4 areas of action
 - ❑ activities => outputs/services =>
use of services => benefits, results
- ❖ **M+E pragmatism: What matters most?**
