#### **Notes on FY08 Budget**

- **Note 1.** An increase of \$150,000 in Core funding is requested in the FY08 budget, from \$1.9 mil. in FY07 to \$2.05 mil. for FY08. This includes approximatly \$110,000 in increased costs for activities noted in the Medium-Term Plan, for increased grant fiduciary and administrative capacity related to increased client execution, and internal staff reorganisation..
- **Note 2.** Norway's contribution is not finalized, but is expected soon.
- Note 3. The FY07 actual in-kind contributions was lower than normal because of gaps of service resulting from staff rotations. The FY08 budget anticipates the full complement of seconded staff, plus the addition on one new secondment, from France. The in-kind posts include: Slum Upgrading Advisor (Farouk Tebbal, UN-Habitat, appointment to Aug. 2008); Urban Economist (Pascale Chabrillat, appointment to January 2008) through the World Bank Staff Exchange Program with France's Caisse des dépôts et consignations (CDC); a secondment from BMZ/GTZ (Guenter Meinert, appointment from July 2007 to July 2008) to initially work on monitoring and evaluation. Thierry Paulais of France AfD is expected to join the secretariat by the end of Sept. 2007, and will work primarily on municipal finance activities.
- **Note 4.** The Management & Administration staff budget is net of \$40,000 in staff costs anticipated to be charged to Non-core activities, for their supervision. The budget also reflects adjustments made as part of a staff reorganization; an additional administrative staff member is being added, and a high paid administrative staff is being transitioned to the slum upgrading team.
- **Note 5.** Operating costs are expected to increase in FY08 due to growth in staff anticipated in this FY08 budget; and, because of increased translation and postal/courier/dissemination costs.
- **Note 6.** Travel costs are expected to increase because the 2008 annual meeting will be held in Manila instead of Washington, and because of increased travel costs related to growth in technical/substantive staff.
- **Note 7.** Grant fiduciary management costs reflect the increase anticipated in the Medium-Term Plan -- the addition of an administrative support staff to support this function.
- **Note 8.** Costs are budgeted to increase because of the addition of two mid-level professional staff to the CDS and SU teams, to support the senior level secondments. Both are budgeted for mid-year transitions to the teams. One of the staff is a transfer from the Mgt. & Admin. team.
- **Note 9.** The FY08 increase is budgeted for the establishment of two new posts anticipated in the second half of FY08 for a print editor and a web editor.
- **Note 10**. This is for the Cities Alliance annual report, and for CA brochures and other organizational materials.

**Note 11.** The FY08 increase is budgeted for consultants to temporarily provide the required additional technical and communication/knowledge sharing services, while the new posts indicated in Notes 8 and 9 are approved and implemented during the course of FY08.
