authorities, citizens, etc.)**

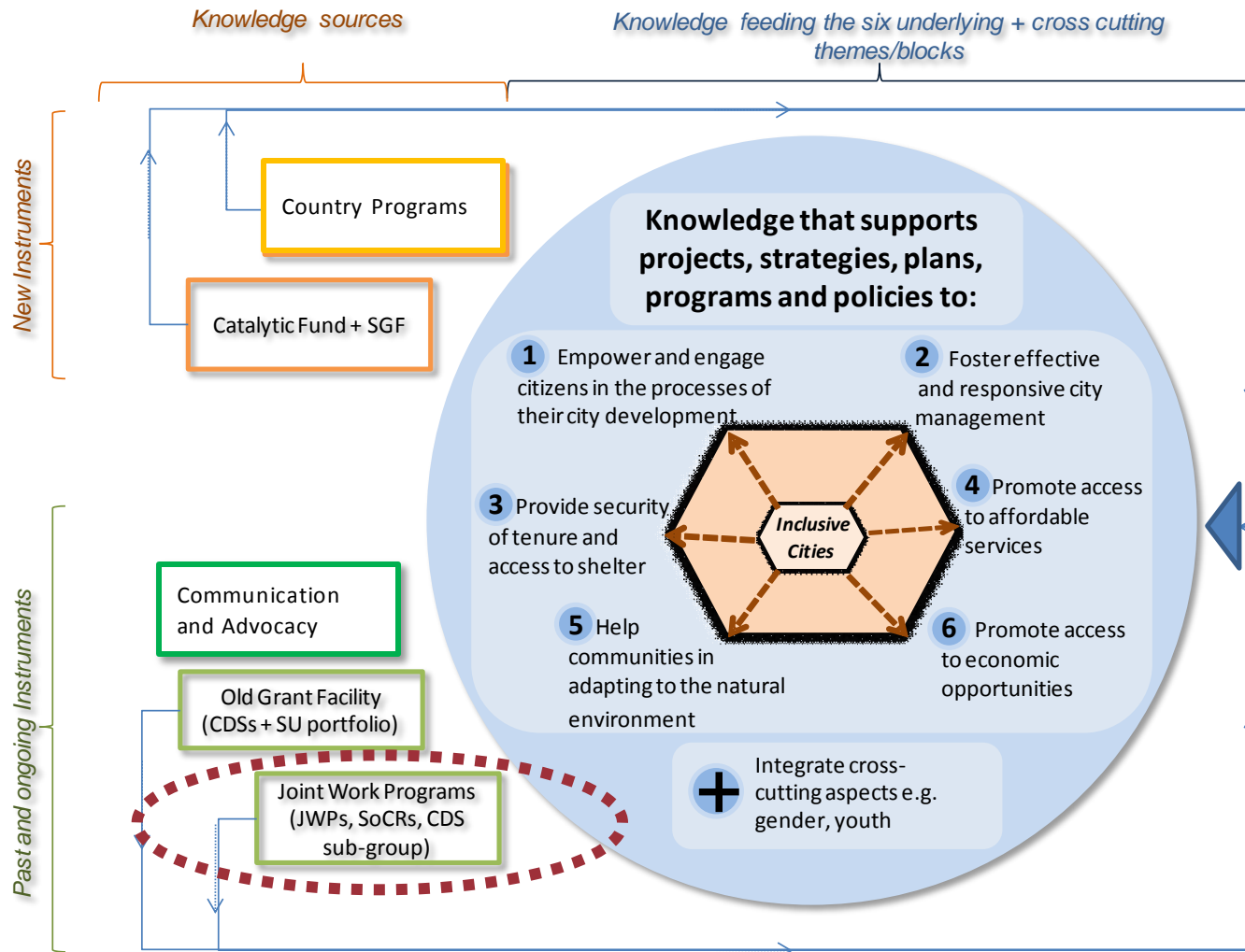

Supporting inclusive urban development:



Work programmes on Environment

- Joint Work Program on **Cities and Climate Change** with UNEP, UN-Habitat and the WB
- Joint Program with UNEP on fully integrating the **environmental dimension into CDSs and SUs**, (and the urban dimension into UNEP's work programme)
- Joint Program with the World Bank to understand the linkages between **Climate Change, Disaster Risk and the Urban Poor**
- Joint Program with the World Bank to support the **ECO2 Cities**, in particular training and dissemination

Proposed priorities

- Establishment of a **State of Cities Reports** learning group
- Starting a Joint Work Programme on **incremental urbanization in Africa**
- Expanding the **CDS working group**, also to the Inclusive Cities Network, enhance integration of inclusion, environment, gender
- Continuation of JWP on **cities and climate change**
- Continuation of integrating the broader **Environment** into CA activities
- Continue mainstreaming **Gender and Youth** in CA activities
